This is an introductory learning position suited for upper-level and graduate-level graphic design students. We are looking for a detail-oriented, enthusiastic graphic designer who understands high-quality and high-end design. This is an introductory learning position suited for undergraduate and graduate college levels. This position reports to the Senior Designer and works closely with the small team members. You will learn the full cycle of “creative work,” including proposal development, story creation, logo design, branding, package graphics, motion video creation, social media assets, and a style guide during this internship. As your time in the office is limited, we may not cover all of the design topics above. You will be assigned to the project(s) that are available at the time.

What You'll Do:

- Assist in the development/brainstorming of unique and innovative concepts based on pre-determined business objectives.
- Assist in creating branding projects, including high-quality print materials, packaging, logo design, front-facing graphics, motion graphics, interior graphics, UI for websites and apps.
- Assist in the retouching and production of graphics works.
- Execute non-template projects from start to finish.
- Proactively seek and research information and data on project requirements to ensure clarity and alignment on timelines, deliverables, and assets.
- Other duties as assigned.

Requirements:

- 3rd or 4th year undergraduate preferred
- Attending a senior-level BA in Graphic Design
- Strong fundamental layout skills--accurately, quickly, artistically lay out diagrams and text.
- Understanding the values for both digital and print design.
- Strong interpersonal and communication skills to communicate with staff.
- Must be self-motivated and able to work effectively with minimal supervision.

- Expert skills in Adobe Suite: Photoshop, Illustrator, and InDesign.
- Premiere Pro or After Effects Knowledge a Plus
- Experience with animation graphics, 3D/2D motion design, and UI Design a plus.
